## **Event Overview**

The Mother's Luncheon is a heartfelt gathering dedicated to honoring and celebrating mothers of children with autism. This special occasion provides an uplifting and memorable experience filled with encouragement, fellowship, and community support. Through creative table designs and thoughtful details, we aim to make each mother feel valued, appreciated, and cherished.

We are seeking **29 individuals or businesses** to serve as table designers. Each designer will be recognized with signage on their table and acknowledged in the official luncheon program.

## **Designer Responsibilities**

Each designer will prepare one **60-inch round table** for **eight** mothers.

🌸 **Dinnerware:** Eight complete place settings consisting of a dinner plate, luncheon/salad plate, and cup with saucer (cups without saucers are acceptable). The luncheon/salad plate will be used for dessert. Bowls and bread-and-butter plates are not required.

🌸 **Shared Dish Sets:** If you do not have the necessary dinnerware, the committee has several sets available to share. [Please contact me to reserve a set.](#)

🌸 **Centerpiece:** Each table should feature a thoughtful centerpiece that one of the mothers can take home as a keepsake. Examples include a vase of fresh flowers, a potted plant, decorative basket filled with themed items, or other meaningful items. Ensure all items are suitable to be gifted.

🌸 **Napkins:** Eight cloth or formal paper napkins. Avoid plain white unless marked for identification.

🌸 **Favors:** Eight small take-home gifts, one for each mother. These may be presented in a gift bag, wrapped individually, or offered unwrapped in a tasteful manner. Favors should be simple, thoughtful tokens of appreciation.

🌸 **Tablecloth:** A 90-inch round tablecloth is required. Affordable options are available online, and a limited number of extras may be reserved through the committee. Available colors include white, black, dark green, brown, pale yellow, lime green, light/dark purple, and light/dark turquoise. **Please contact me early to reserve a tablecloth**, which will be placed on your table during setup.

🌸 **Theme & Decorations:** The theme and design of your table are entirely up to you. We encourage creativity, imagination, and joy in the process. Each year, mothers delight in admiring the variety of table designs and enjoy selecting their favorite place to sit.
